🕞 19th June : The focus this week was on festivals and the importance of fasting to Muslims


igcellet 26th June: Students this week watched clips on Islamic worship and Wudhu

Maths

Spiritual - Enforcing church on factory workers.


Moral - Child workers doing the most dangerous jobs in factories and pits and linking to child exploitation today.
