28B – 20 th April	Hot desert environments- You will be required to have an understanding of the characteristics of hot desert environments: Soil, climate, plants and animals. Key words: Biotic and Abiotic. 29A – 27 th April	Plant adaptations- You are required to know how and why plants have adapted to live within the desert regions. Not only do you need to be aware of the adaptation but you must understand why the plant has had to adapt in that way. E.g small leaves - these ensure that less water is lost from the plant by transpiration because the leaf has a smaller surface area- this is due to the sever lack of rainfall which is limited the amount of nutrients that are passed through the soils and into the roots. Add to your working document (note book/PowerPoint/ revision clock etc.) Make sure you have the name of the plant/ its adaptation/ why that adaptation is important.
