



School Uniform

The school uniform is considered a very important aspect of the school's ethos and full uniform is expected to be worn by all of our students every day.

Year 7 - 10 uniform consists of:

- **A black blazer with a red trim and the school badge**
- A white shirt/blouse
- **School clip-on tie**; no other type is permitted
- Black school trousers or black school skirt - girls' trousers must be tailored
- Flat, plain black shoes (boots and training shoes are not permitted)
- A school jumper, tank top or black cardigan may be worn provided they are fine knit.
- Plain black or white below the knee socks or black tights

PE Kit:

- **Black and red polo shirt with logo (girls)**
- **Black and red Football top with logo (boys)**
- **Black and red shorts with logo**
- Black socks
- Trainers
- football boots/shin pads (optional)
- Towel

Instead of the school blazer, students should wear a professional looking black suit jacket. Girls must wear an open neck reverse blouse with no tie. Boys should wear a **plain, dark green tie**.

The items in **red** are only available from Wirral Uniforms.

Other compulsory uniform items may be purchased from any local supplier as long as they are not branded. These include black trousers or black skirt and white shirt.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ONLY FLAT, PLAIN BLACK SHOES are allowed.

No footwear with a coloured trim or logo will be allowed.

Each student will be given a complimentary school bag on the first day of term, as well as receiving a lanyard representing their house, one of the four school values.
