Year 11 Autumn Assessment: Tuesday 12 – Monday 18 November

Students in Year 11 will sit their assessments during the week beginning Monday 11 November. These assessments will give teachers the opportunity to accurately assess their attainment and progress, and will assist students in preparing more thoroughly for the new-style GCSE examinations they will encounter in May 2020. As with any assessment, it is essential that your child takes the time to revise in order to achieve their full potential.

Examination Arrangements

Students will sit their assessments in the hall or gym. A copy of the exam timetable is included on the reverse of this letter and is also available on our school website. All students must be punctual for their assessments. The equipment they require (pens, pencils, ruler etc.) should be in their clear pencil case. Students must also ensure that they have **NO** mobile phones (or other handheld electronic device), smart watches or revision material with them during any assessments.
