### **Year 11 Parents' Evening – Thursday 3 March 4:00pm – 6:30pm**

I am delighted to share that that we can welcome you to school for face to face meetings on **Thursday 3 March, 4:00pm – 6:30pm** for the Year 11 Parents' Evening. This will be the last formal opportunity for you to speak to your child's teachers before the start of the external exams in May 2022.

Your child will be issued with an appointment card that they will use to make appointments with their teachers. Staff will set aside time in lessons so the students can do this, and Miss Galer will check on the progress they are making in this task.

### **Year 11 Internal Assessments – Monday 7 March – Monday 21 March**

To support teachers to accurately assess your child's progress and prepare them for the external public examinations in the summer, we have scheduled subject assessments to take place in school from **Monday 7 March to Monday 21 March**.

- The focus of the assessments is for the students to demonstrate what they know from content that has been taught by their teacher.
- The assessments will take place in the Hall and the Gym, the full timetable is included in this pack.
- Appropriate access arrangements will be provided and students will be allowed to use support materials allowed by the exam board.

In order for your son/daughter to achieve their potential, a collaborative approach between parents/carers is essential, it is important that you find a balance between enjoying the half term break but also taking the time to schedule a consistent revision timetable. Students have been encouraged to take their books home, and revision resources have been uploaded onto Microsoft TEAMS.
