Dear Parents

Further to Mrs Johnson's letter regarding the daily programme of remote learning after half term, I am pleased to share the precise arrangements for Year 11.

Year 11 Remote learning Monday 7th June – Friday 18th June.

We have scheduled the additional subject content to be taught remotely from Monday 7th June until Friday 18th June. This includes a daily pastoral session with Ms Galer during Period 1, followed by 3 lessons each day running from period 2 to period 4.

The lessons will be delivered using Microsoft Teams, on the day the teacher will call the Year 11 Channel for them to attend their virtual lesson. Please can you ensure that your child has this set up in advance and that they are logged in ready to join the lesson. They should be familiar with the technology as we used TEAMS for remote teaching with all students during the lockdown at the start of this year.

I have included the schedule below with the member of staff delivering the session, students will also receive a personalised timetable before half term.
