I hope that this letter finds you and your families safe and well. Firstly, may I take the opportunity to thank you for your support during what has been a successful Spring Term so far. I would also like to share with you some key information regarding Year 11 mock exams and interventions.

Year 11 Mock Exams – Monday 10 February – Friday 14 February

To support teachers in accurately assessing your child's progress and prepare them for the external public examinations in the summer, we have scheduled mock exams.

- The focus of the assessments is for the students to demonstrate what they know from content that has been taught by their teacher.
- The assessments will take place in the Hall and the Gym.
- Appropriate access arrangements will be provided, and it is important that if your child does receive access arrangements that they take full advantage of these.
- The exams will take place over one week in order to minimise disruption to curriculum time.
- Please note that the start of exams will be 8.35am prompt. This is to allow students to form positive learning habits in readiness for their summer exams.
- For those students who take Art there will be an additional exam session for them after half term in order to prepare for their 10 hour exam.

Intervention Programme and Revision Strategies

As a school, we value the huge importance of revision and instilling academic resilience. Your child should already be revising at home independently in order to prepare for their exams. Teachers will be uploading revision resources onto Class Charts, and providing your child with revision packs to tailor their independent study at home. Please encourage them to revise at home so they can have the best chance of success.

To support them in school, we are offering a full intervention programme for them to take advantage of. This includes both lunch time and after school sessions. Can I also take the opportunity to remind you that Year 11 form time is also dedicated to additional revision sessions. Your child should be in school every day on time in order to benefit from this.
