## Year 8 – English

Week:	Instructions to Parents/Students
28B – 20 <sup>th</sup> April	<i>“Young people are too often and too easily blamed for everything that is wrong with society today”</i> <b>Write an article for a newspaper to explain your point of view.</b>
29A – 27 <sup>th</sup> May	<i>It was cold. The man shivered. He was worried about what had happened. He didn’t know what to do.</i> <b>Write the opening of a story about this man. What has happened to him?</b>
30B – 4 <sup>th</sup> May	<i>‘School Uniform stifles individuality and should be scrapped.’</i> <b>Write the text of a speech for an assembly to your peers in which you explain your point of view.</b>
31A – 11 <sup>th</sup> May	<b>Create a Facebook profile (On paper) for your favourite fictional character from a book.</b> <i>Remember to include factual information (D.O.B, education, hometown) and also status updates of what they’re thinking.</i>
32B – 18 <sup>th</sup> May	<b>Write a detailed diary entry on what you would consider being ‘Your Perfect Day’ but you cannot spend any money.</b> You must link this to a historical event and use a simile.
33A – 1 <sup>st</sup> June	<b>Write a newspaper article relevant to a novel you’ve studied this year.</b> <i>Include specific, accurate information, with correct English. You could include images and/or quotes. Have a look at a newspaper for some inspiration!</i>
34B – 8 <sup>th</sup> June	<i>‘Slowly opening my eyes I saw something...’</i> <b>Write a short story that starts with the above sentence.</b>
35A – 15 <sup>th</sup> June	<b>Create your own superhero and write a story with them in it.</b> Finished? Draw a comic strip of what happened in your story.
36B – 22 <sup>nd</sup> June	<i>‘The arrival’</i> <b>Write a film script using this title.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Include stage directions</i></li><li>• <i>Speech</i></li></ul> <i>Set the location and what you expect the characters to look like at the start.</i>
37A – 29 <sup>th</sup> June	<b>Write your own story about anything you want.</b> <i>It must:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Have a clear structure</i></li><li>• <i>Have interesting characters</i></li><li>• <i>Use a range of language techniques.</i></li><li>• <i>Use a range of punctuation.</i></li></ul>

38B – 6 <sup>th</sup> July	<b>Write the opening chapter of a sequel to a story or film you have recently seen.</b> Make sure you include the characters from the previous story. Make sure it links to the first story. Use similes and Metaphors.
