## Year 9 - Music

Week:	Instructions to Parents/Students. Work based on the BTEC Unit 2 Managing a music product
28B – 20 <sup>th</sup> April	Music festivals in the UK – RESEARCH TASK. List as many different UK Music Festivals as you can and then research more information about each one – Create a table with the main facts about each festival. Remember to include venue, location, musical genre and target audience for each one.
29A – 27 <sup>th</sup> April	Draw or find a map of the UK from the internet and label where the different UK Music Festivals you have identified above take place. Create an item of promotional material for example a poster to advertise ONE of the UK Music Festivals above.
30B – 4 <sup>th</sup> May	Imagine you were in charge of the band line up for ONE of the UK Music Festivals and create a poster to advertise the "Set Times" – who is playing on which day, at which time, and on which stage.
31A – 11 <sup>th</sup> May	Research the history of ONE of the UK Music Festival venues and write a short account or create a PowerPoint about it.
32B – 18 <sup>th</sup> May	Create a 3D "SITE PLAN" of your music festival using colour, illustrate where you will place and locate your facilities and "performance areas". How will your Music Festival be laid out? Will you have a "Main Stage"? Will you have other stages, marquees or performance areas?
33A – 1 <sup>st</sup> June	Create and design a professionally-presented poster of your "Set Times & Line-Up" for your own Music Festival. (See the school website for examples).
34B – 8 <sup>th</sup> June	Planning your own Music festival. Give your festival a name, think of 8 pieces of equipment that would be needed and 8 artists and songs that could be performed.
35A – 15 <sup>th</sup> June	Draw a poster to advertise your Music Festival and write a letter to your Heads of Year giving all the details so they can pass the information on to their year groups.
36B – 22 <sup>nd</sup> June	My favourite style of music is Describe your favorite type/style/genre of music – include images/photos/illustrations.
37A – 29 <sup>th</sup> June	My most memorable song Describe your most memorable song giving the song title and artist/band/group – use photos, images and illustrations and say why this song is memorable to you and what makes it memorable.
38B – 6 <sup>th</sup> July	I would like to spend 10 minutes with Describe who you would like to spend 10 minutes with and what question or questions you would like to ask them.
39A – 13 <sup>th</sup> July	The last concert I went to Describe the last concert or live music performance you went to, who or what you saw and what you liked or disliked about it (watch a concert on youtube if needed).
