Scope and Purpose

This guidance document is for use by all staff in the event of BSA centre approval being lost to teach with any awarding body.

Guidance

In the event of Approval being lost for BSA to run courses with an awarding body, BSA will take the following actions.

- 1. As all awarding bodies are different at first instance achievements should attempt to obtain an interim certificate from online systems to ensure proof of current units obtained by students.
- 2. If this is not possible, BSA will contact awarding bodies to obtain proof of current achievement to pass to the students.
- 3. BSA will notify the funding agencies and work with them to find an alternative provider for students to transfer to and carry on their studies.
- 4. The Head of Centre will support and guide BSA during this process.
