Please note that we have changed the way we calculate and report **apprenticeships**. Students staying in an apprenticeship for at least six consecutive months of the following academic year are counted. We now report them in the apprenticeship category only and not in education or employment as well. This removes double counting between apprenticeships and other categories.

We provide this information to help you know which of your former students we have recorded as staying in education for two full terms (October to March) or in an apprenticeship for at least six consecutive months. **Please note this is not a checking exercise and we do not require feedback on whether our records match information you may already hold.**
