Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to provide an update regarding remote learning for students working from home in Y7-Y10. Firstly, I would like to thank you for your feedback and for your patience whilst we navigate what is a very new way of teaching and learning.

Our new approach aims to streamline resources in a way that makes them easier to access by students who are working independently from their classroom teachers. Therefore, from Monday 15th June, we will be taking the following approach:

- A weekly work pack will be posted home to all students in Y7-Y10
- The pack will include all work from all key subjects from that week
- Students should aim to complete all the work relevant to them in the booklet over the course of the week (Y9-Y10 should select the option subjects they study)
- The following week, students will receive their new learning pack plus the support necessary for them to self-assess their learning from the week before
- A pre-paid envelope will be provided so that work can be returned to school once students have reflected on their learning using the self-assessment material provided.

Whilst all students will receive a pack through the post, if your child is currently accessing their work via Google Classroom, they can continue to do so. The work on Google Classroom will mirror the work in the weekly booklet. They will not need to post the booklet back to school as it will be submitted electronically. There will also be an additional electronic copy of the booklet on the Unity Academy website under the Remote Learning link should you need it.

Year 10 students, who will be making a partial return to school during the week beginning 15th June, will receive a pack when they are in school. Apologies if they receive a duplicate copy in the post; they only need to complete one copy for returning to school.

Work booklets can be returned to school either by posting it back using the pre-paid envelope, through submission on Google Classroom, or in a drop box at the free school meal collection point.
