
As we are al housebound it would be an excellent idea if we could complete some of the research sections of units we haven't started yet. (I know how much you love research)

(A few years ago BP were charged over £100 million to rebrand their company.)
- What are the entry requirements to become a GRAPHIC DESIGNER?

What qualifications would you have to achieve to become a graphic designer? (most students would take the route of a degree and some would go on to a masters degree in a specific area of graphic design. Some students would opt for a low paid graphic design job after they finish college and try to climb the ladder. Some designers go on to become freelance and work from home for themselves.)
