Important Update: Last Day of Term

Please note a change to our schedule for **Friday**, **19th December**:

Why the change? We are using this time for essential staff training to plan improvements for the new term. This helps us ensure consistent, high-quality support for every child.

Return Date: All pupils return on Monday, 5th January.

What have we been up to this week?

In primary this week our RRS behaviour curriculum was focused on respecting the environment. This is important because when children learn to care for the environment—by throwing rubbish in the bin, tidying the environment, helping water a plant, or turning off the tap—they are learning that everything matters. These small actions teach them that they are an important part of a bigger world and that their choices can help keep our community and nature healthy and beautiful. By teaching them respect for the environment now, we are raising happy, thoughtful children who will grow up knowing how to take care of themselves and the planet!

This week, we've been shining a spotlight on Anti-Bullying Week across the secondary phase. Our Anti-Bullying Ambassadors have been out and about visiting form groups and distributing anti-bullying stickers to keep the message visible and positive throughout the week.

Year 8 have completed their careers questionnaire, helping us build a clearer picture of their interests and future pathways. Meanwhile, Year 11 have been pushing through the final stretch of their mock exams with real determination.

Finally, on Friday, we welcomed the BBC Bitesize Careers Tour, who delivered engaging careers sessions with pupils from Year 5 through to Year 10. The team were fantastic with the students, and we were also joined by Andy Bayes from BBC Radio Lancashire, who brought real insight into local media careers. Staff commented on how inspired the pupils were — a brilliant boost to aspiration and future-thinking across the school.

Y6 SATs

Year 6's first set of mock SATs week begins very shortly - week beginning **Monday 24th November to Thursday 27th November.** This is a very important week as it makes clear the children's current position in regard to meeting the expected standard. It also highlights any gaps in knowledge that we can then work in over the next few months. Remember our expectation is that all children are: 'in school on time, every day' - but especially that week!!

We run the mock SATS week as closely as possible to the real SATs week. Our experience tells us that this means that the children are very well prepared and then take the full opportunity to show off how amazing they are when it comes to the testing week in May!
