Session 1: Pages 4 - 8 of the geographical skills booklet.

Complete the symbols for the table on page 5. On page 7 attempt the six figure grid references on the map. On page 8 attempt to match the correct word to the definition.

Session 2: Pages 9 - 12 of the geographical skills booklet.

Attempt to identify the features along the cross sections. On page 10 attempt all questions. On page 11 attempt all questions and try to do a sketch map with detailed symbols. Create a sketch map of Fort Williamson on page 12.

Session 3: Pages 13 - 16 of the geographical skills booklet.

Read through pages 13 – 14. Attempt all descriptions on page 14. On page 16 attempt all lines of longitude and latitude.

Session 4: Pages 17 - 20 of the geographical skills booklet.

Read through all sections on aerial and satellite photographs. Attempt all questions on each page.

Session 5: Pages 21 - 24 of the geographical skills booklet.

Read through each technique and highlight key information. If you are able to, visit www.teachitgeography.co.uk/skills and annotate each of the skills on there.

Session 6: Pages 25 - 27 of the geographical skills booklet.

Read through each of the sections and attempt the questions on isolines.

Session 7: Pages 28 - 31 of the geographical skills booklet.

Read through pages 28 and 31 and attempt all practice questions from the booklet.

Session 8: Pages 32 - 34 of the geographical skills booklet.

Read through 32 to 34 and attempt the questions that are on each of the pages.

Session 9: Pages 35 - 40 of the geographical skills booklet.

Read through each of the pages and highlight any key bits of information that stand out. Once you are familiar with each of the practice techniques attempt all the questions.

Session 10: Pages 41 on wards of the geographical skills booklet.
