## Subject Specific Vocabulary

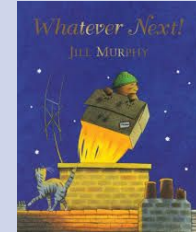
astronaut	a person who is trained to travel in a spacecraft.

N.A.S.A	NASA.gov. NASA or the National Aeronautics and Space Administration is the part of the United States government that deals with space exploration and aeronautics, the operating and designing of planes. NASA has had many successful missions including the ISS and Apollo 11 which put the first man on the Moon in 1969.
Moon	the natural satellite of the earth, visible (chiefly at night) by reflected light from the sun.
Earth	A planet in the Solar System where humans live.
pilot	a person who operates the flying controls of an aircraft
Commander	a person in authority, especially over a body of troops or a military operation
orbit	To travel around.

## Neil Armstrong Facts

Neil Armstrong was the first human to walk on the moon during the NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration) Apollo 11 mission on 20th July 1969. He completed the mission alongside co-pilots Edwin E. "Buzz" Aldrin and Michael Collins.
