

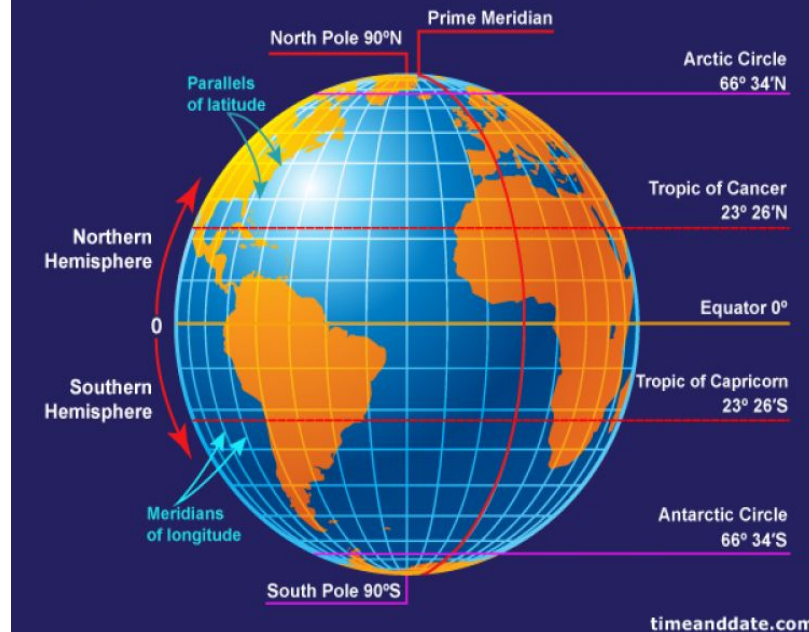

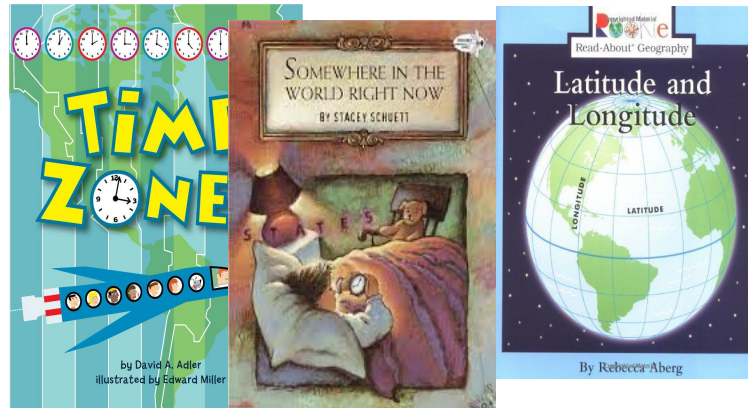
## What do I need to know?
