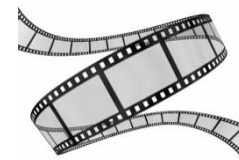

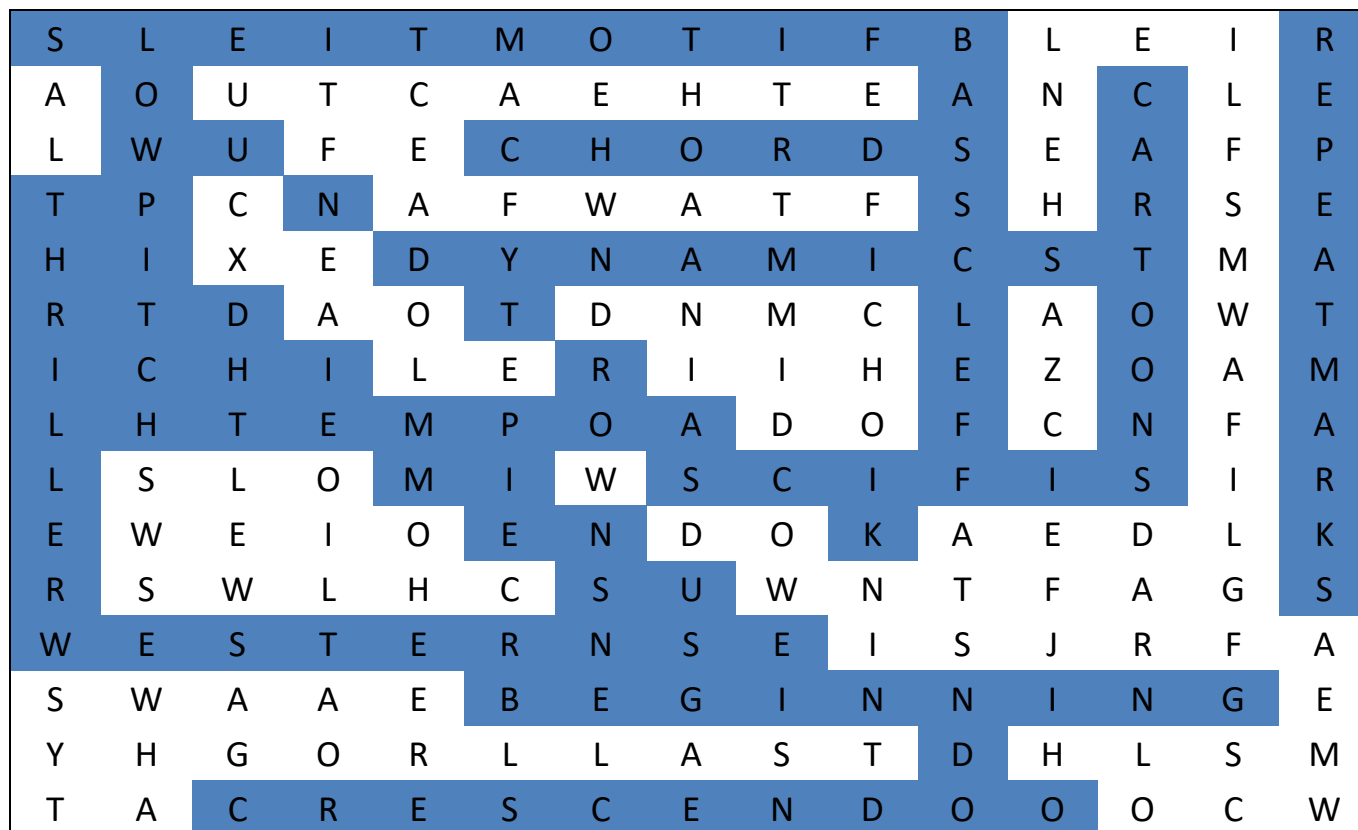

This word search revises some musical words we are learning about on **FILM MUSIC**.

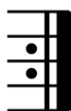
Answer the questions below and then see if you can find all the answers in the grid.

3. This musical symbol is called the **BASS CLEF**. It tells you to perform the notes at **LOW PITCH**.
4. When the volume of the music gets gradually louder, this is called a **CRESCENDO**.
5. A short musical theme which represents a character in a film is called a **LEITMOTIF**.
6. When the volume of the music gets gradually softer, this is called a **DIMINUENDO**.



7. These musical symbols are called **REPEAT MARKS**. They tell us to go back to the **BEGINNING** and play the music again.
8. We learned to play some **THEMES** used in music for James Bond Films. The James Bond Leitmotif used notes which were played together. These are called **CHORDS**.
