### **The Jewish Federation**

We provide a range of support services to children and young people in our on-site childrens centre. These include one to one support, family support, afterschool clubs, play schemes, summer camps and regular days out. All of the children and young people (CYP) supported by our service have complex physical and learning disabilities as well as health and social care needs. The majority of the children are from the Jewish community. They are disadvantaged in numerous ways including through ill health, complex disabilities, poverty, caring responsibilities, safeguarding issues, parental ill health or large, chaotic families. Many of those we support live in areas of high levels of deprivation and live in food and fuel poverty as well as poor housing.

Our activities will comprise of the following;

- Sports and physical exercise sessions including an intergenerational sports event with older people living as residents at Heathlands Village.
- Arts, crafts, and baking including as focus on nutrition and healthy eating.
- A nature walk, gardening, tending our sensory garden with herbs.
- Several day trips out to local attractions and parks, soft play as well as the zoo.
- A cycling event on-site and a trip to a local cycling track.
- Baking Challah bread and making Challah bread boxes
- Plenty of free play with other children including circus skills, animal therapy

Accessible, free transport will be provided to enable children and young people to attend and get home. We will offer 5 children from Bury a place on our playscheme. The children will be aged 4-15 years old. Children will undertake health and fitness activities for at least one hour a day. The activities will include cycling proficiency skills, sports day, physical games, and lots of outside play. The sessions will be offered to children in Bury living with complex disabilities and social care needs. The sessions will take place in our Children's Centre which is a bright modern building with specialist play equipment and adaptations for disabled children as well as toys and books. There is a sensory garden where children can spend time outdoors. The majority of the children who will attend the groups will have a limited social life due to their health conditions. They may require one to one support in a calm and well-staffed environment
