

Day 1: Tuesday, 02 April 2024


01:00 hrs	Group to meet the coach at school and load luggage.

Please drop your child off at Unsworth Academy at 01:00 on Tuesday 2nd April.


We will arrive in Dover in time to board the 09:30 **ferry** which is scheduled to arrive in Calais at 12:00

Please collect your child at Unsworth Academy at 22:30 (we will advise if this changes)



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



Travel tips – money


The currency in Paris is the Euro.

Students will need some money (Pounds and Euros) to purchase food/drinks/snacks during their stay.

Students may also want to bring some additional spending money (e.g. to spend at Disneyland)

Each student will be allocated a group leader. If you want that teacher to be responsible for looking after your money, parents must inform us of this before departure. Otherwise, students will be responsible for any money they bring.

Travel tips – packing

The weather in Paris at this time of year is changeable.

Average maximum daily temperature is 17°C and average minimum daily temperature is 8°C.

We would recommend you pack the following items:

Suitcase or Rucksack

Passport and GHIC card

Clothing for 3 days (consider possible weather conditions)

Food/snacks for journeys

Hoodie – this is to be worn when travelling on the coach/ferry

Coat

Phone and phone charger (and headphones) – ***please note students are responsible for any devices brought and their safe-keeping***

European plug adapters

Suitable shoes (this trip will include LOTS of walking!)

Towels

Toiletries

Refillable water bottle

Blanket/pillow for the coach

Small rucksack for use on the coach (luggage will not be accessible during the journeys)


Any medication (clearly labelled with your name)

Day 1:

Ferry – when we get on the ferry, students will all go to a designated meeting point. Staff will be available at this meeting point throughout the journey. They will be allowed to explore the shops and visit the café in small groups. We will meet back here before going back to the coach.

Cite de Science – we will arrive together and students will explore the museum, meeting back together at a designated meeting point at a certain time (TBC)

Hotel – students will not be allowed into any rooms other than their own. Every evening, staff will ensure that students are in their own room before lights out.

Disneyland Paris

Students will be allowed to explore the parks in a minimum of pairs.

Between 2 and 3pm, students are asked to come and check in with staff at a designated meeting point.

At the end of the day, we will meet at the same meeting point before getting on the coach.

All students will have the school phone number on their lanyards (which one of the teachers on the trip will have at all times)
