## Choices and consequences

CC1 First verbal warning, poor choice logged on SIMS	Counselling Conversation with classroom teacher
CC2 Second verbal warning, possible 5 minutes after lesson, poor choices logged on SIMS	Guidance by HOD when removed to another classroom, counselled by classroom teacher during 30 minute department detention
CC3 Removed to another classroom, parent/carer contacted, poor choices logged on SIMS	Reflection Sheet completed in I.E. This is used as template for conversation with Progress Leader/Pastoral Manager to explore further support (e.g. department report/progress report, referral to SEMH team, RAR with member of staff)
CC4 - HOD requests "on call" Referred to Internal Exclusion, parent/carer contacted. SLT Detention and poor choices logged on SIMS

- **If confiscated they will be placed in school safe for parents to collect.**

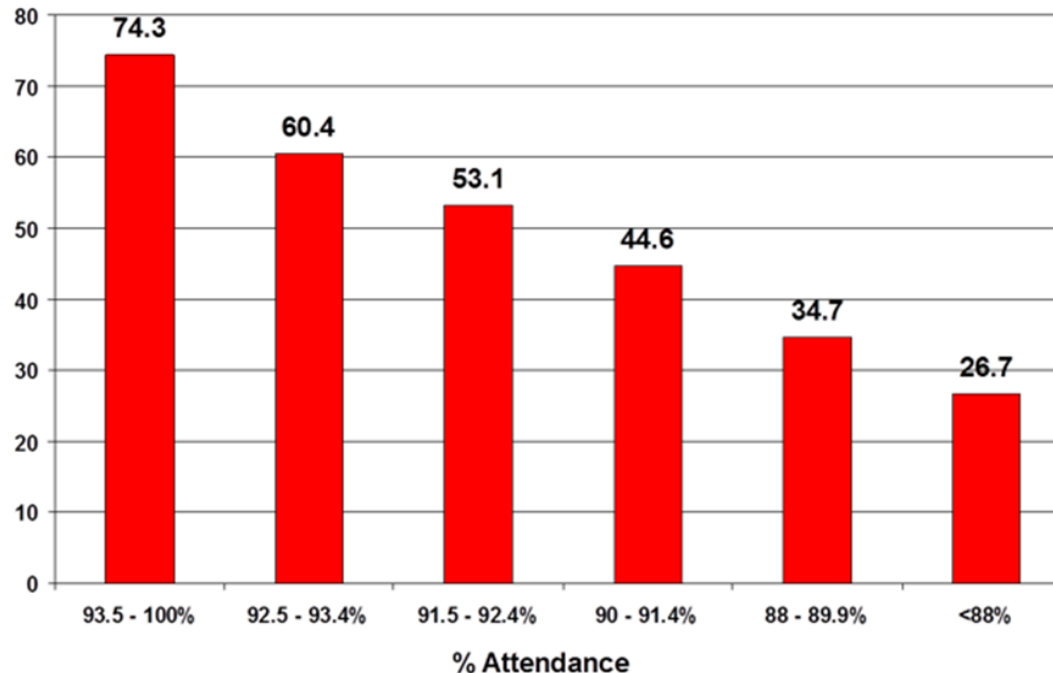


# Outstanding Attendance

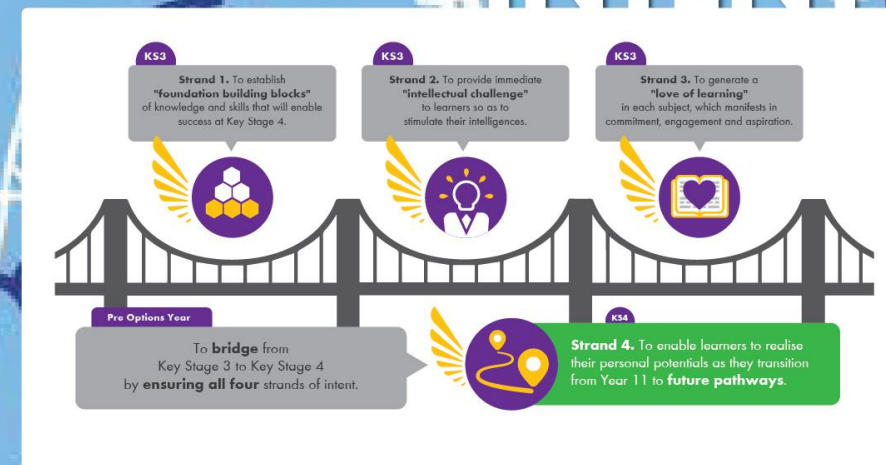

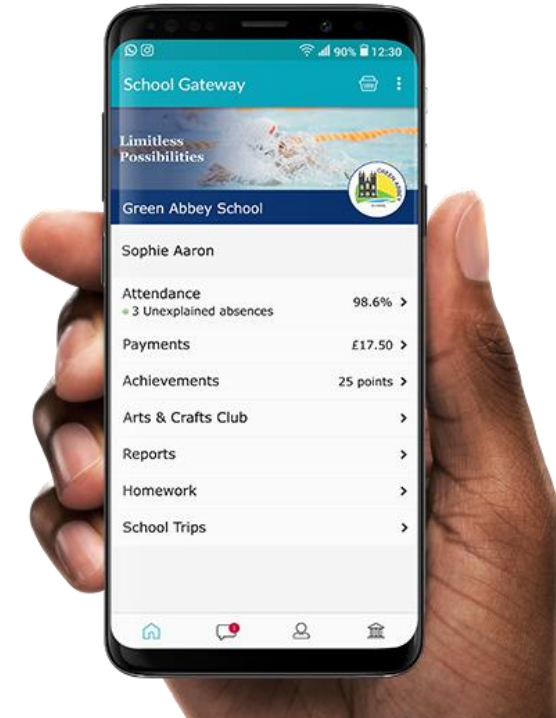
