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## Eindhoven 2024 – BEHAVIOUR CONTRACT (CODE OF CONDUCT)

For this visit to be both beneficial and enjoyable for all, you will be expected to comply with the following code of conduct.

In general, you will be expected to:

- Always behave responsibly and show consideration for others.
- Always comply with staff and instructors' instructions.
- Understand the rules concerning the purchase, possession, and consumption of alcohol.
- Understand the rules concerning the purchase, possession, and use of tobacco.
- **Understand the rules concerning the purchase, possession and use of e-cigarettes and vapes.**
- Understand that the possession and use of non-prescribed drugs and/or illegal substances is strictly forbidden.
- Safeguard your personal belongings.

On the coach

- Remain in your seat, unless given permission to do otherwise.  
Wear your seat belt whilst travelling on the coach.
- Luggage should not block the aisle and be kept on the luggage rack or under the seat.
- Litter should be put in the bags provided.
- Do not distract the driver – no shouting out, no flash photography, loud music etc.
- If you begin to feel travel sick, inform a member of staff.
- When disembarking, be aware of traffic movement and direction.
- **No Bluetooth or portable speakers**
- **No fizzy drinks**
- **No aerosol spray deodorants**

On the ferry

- Remaining in a group at these busy locations – don't go off on your own.
- Remain inside your cabins from the allocated time.
- Ensure that you know the allocated meeting point.
- Follow instructions from crew members in the event of an emergency.
- Follow all instructions regarding being on boat decks.
- Visit shops in groups - never alone.
- Arrive promptly at our allocated mealtime.

Staying in the hotel

- Ensure that you read all notices and understand all instructions regarding fire and safety procedures.
- Ensure that you understand the location of duty staff.
- Never leave the hotel without permission.
- Ensure that you understand any instructions, which limit your access to parts of the hotel. e.g. bar, spa,
- Ensure that you understand all instructions regarding access to other peoples' bedrooms.
- Ensure that you arrive on time for meals and meetings. Attending mealtimes is compulsory.

- Inappropriate use of social media, including sharing of images, will be challenged in line with school policy.

Football Sessions

- Treat coaches with the same respect you would any other member of staff
- Wear the correct footwear and shinpads.

Stadium

- Ensure that you sit in the seats provided.
- Ensure you are aware of the meeting point location.
- Ensure if you go to the toilet or food kiosk that you do so in groups.
- Ensure you have your mobile and contact card.
- Ensure you don't use foul or inappropriate language.
- Ensure you stay with the group when walking to and from the stadium.

Fixtures

- Walk to and from the fixtures as a group.
- Don't remain in changing rooms or visit toilet facilities alone.
- Treat teammates, opposition players and the referee with upmost respect
- Ensure when on the sidelines you behave appropriately and support your teammates.
- Take any litter with you and place in the closest bin

**Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in sanctions on the trip, or disciplinary action upon our return to school.**

## Friday

# Packing

While many activities and food almost all food and drink are paid for, below are a list of instances where spending money will be possible. The ferry accepts either euros or sterling.

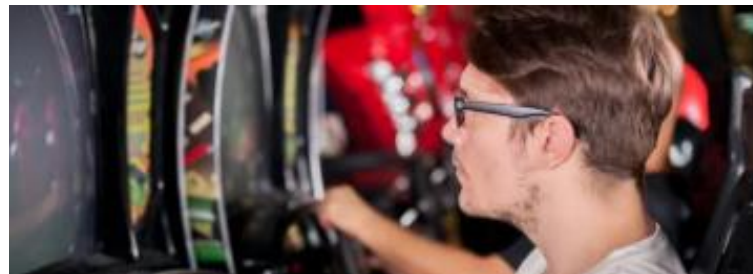
- Ferry Shop (£/€)

# The Ferry

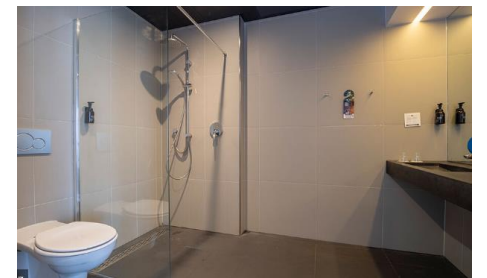

# Medical
