

Dear Parents,

Attached is the home learning for your child while they are unable to come into school. Please use the exercise book in your child's pack to record any work and it will be marked when your child returns to school. Please record the reading in your child's reading diary.

The learning below uses the Oak National Academy which has been set up by the Government to support children and schools during the Covid pandemic. Each session covers a national curriculum objective and has a teacher to take your child through the learning. Your little person will need support with concentration and focus and the videos can be paused and watched as many times as needed.

Either click directly onto the blue link or type the address into your web browser. You can also search the Oak National Academy website, The text below is to be read to your child.

We are really sorry that you need to stay at home to isolate at the moment. We hope you are feeling okay.

Below is some learning to complete while you feel well. If you become poorly your adults at home might decide you need to stop doing the work.

Each day there are three lessons to complete along with some reading and exercise. These are the things that will make up your new school day while you are at home-

- A Literacy lesson
- A maths lesson
- A Topic activity
- A PE activity
- Reading to an adult.

Below are your lessons for each day – It might be worth watching the videos twice.

Sometimes the video might ask you to pause and do the quiz. Don't worry if you can't do this. The most important thing is to watch the video.
