How do brilliant historians ask and answer questions about their history?

The children will learn about their own personal history by looking at old photographs. They will discuss how they have changed over time.

How do brilliant historians create a family tree?



The children will identify their immediate family. They will be able to discuss key individuals and explain their relation.

How do brilliant historians discuss similarities and differences between ways of life?



The children will compare life now to their parents/grandparents. They will compare toys, school life and transport.
