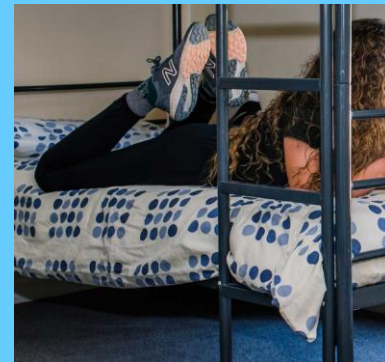
Hooke Court Residential Study Centre is based in the small village of Hooke, West Dorset. Located just 11 miles from the Jurassic Coast it provides fantastic learning environments and offers inspirational activities designed to enhance and stimulate curriculum learning.

Key Features

- **Grade II listed 14th century manor house**
- **Stunning historical, rural location that brings learning to life**
- **Accommodation for up to 190**
- **Camping facilities in the summer months**
- **Twenty-four acres of landscaped grounds and woodlands**
- **Playground, playing fields and low ropes course**
- **All groups are fully catered for and accommodated in their own area**

Accommodation

- On-site – we will be allocated two accommodation blocks which are next to each other. Boys will be in one side and girls in the other.
- Blocks have a children's communal room and a communal outside space to play.
- No sharing with other schools – solely UJS
- Bunk bedded rooms for around 6-10 children.
- Some have ensuites and some shared bathrooms.
- Staff have separate bathrooms to children.
- Bedding is provided but towels are not.



Catering

- Locally sourced and home cooked food
- All dietary requirements catered for
- Packed lunches are provided as well as breakfast and a hot evening meal.
- One evening we may have BBQ or pizza night for dinner.

Sample Menu

Breakfast:

Juice, cereal, beans on toast, hot drink.

Mid-Morning Snack:

Squash and biscuits.

Lunch:*

selection of sandwiches, homemade cake, fruit, yoghurt

Mid-Afternoon Snack:

Squash and biscuits.

Evening Meal:*

Pasta with a homemade tomato & vegetable sauce, served with cheese, garlic bread and salad. Yorkshire pudding with sausage, potato wedges, carrots, peas and gravy. Sweet & sour pork and rice.

Puddings:

Fresh fruit salad. Fruit crumble and custard.

*Salad and fresh fruit are available at all lunch and evening meals.
