Reading:

This term, we will be watching a short film based called 'Alma' which is a suspense story. Then we will be reading Kensuke's Kingdom and Macbeth. Pupils will continue to have the opportunity to develop their reading comprehension skills; vocabulary, inference, prediction, explaining, retrieval and summarising.

Writing:

This term, the children will be doing two main pieces of writing including;

- Alma (film) —Narrative
- The Americas (Geography) - Persuasion

As well as writing, we will be revising grammar from Year 5 and new grammar from Year 6.

Mathematics:

This term, we will cover be revising Maths objectives from Year 3 to 6 ready for SATs.

After SATs, we will be doing Maths investigations and continuing with arithmetic and fluency practice.
