Well-being at UPS

We believe that children learn best when they are happy and safe and so we ensure that this is the case at Urmston Primary. We place our children's and our staff's well-being at the heart of all we do, using our core values to support our children in developing their resilience, whilst providing opportunities to reflect on the choices that they make and the impact that their decisions have on themselves and those around them.

Restorative practice plays a key role in this, helping our young people to develop their respect and sense of responsibility for both their own and others' happiness.

We hope that as they move on from UPS, they then help to make the world a better place.

From the moment the children set foot in our Nursery, they are nurtured and taught the values of happiness and kindness. Our Nursery offers morning, afternoon and all day sessions, where the children are led to explore their natural curiosity and to express themselves through communication and developing relationships.

As they move into Reception, the children build on the behaviours learnt in Nursery, further developing a love of learning and forming the social and emotional skills that will lead them to becoming a key part of our learning community. The children learn in an environment that nurtures inquisitiveness and self-expression and the activities set up are designed not only to create the building blocks for core literacy and numeracy skills, but to stimulate imagination and develop self-confidence.

In the Infants, the children really begin to **grow together**. Our creative KS1 curriculum enables them to deepen their knowledge, develop their skills, and enhance their understanding, all in an atmosphere that allows for creativity, expressiveness and fun.
