

Welcome back everyone,

We are so delighted to have all the children back in school. It was wonderful to see all their smiley faces coming through the gates looking so smart in their uniforms. They have settled back into school life really well and have adapted quickly to the changes.

Now we have had a few days to settle into the routines I wanted to just reiterate a few points to ensure the safety of everyone. It is really important that children arrive on time each day to ensure bubbles do not mix.

During drop off and pick up we ask that you line up along the wall (a safe distance apart) and once you have handed your child over or collected your child you leave. This is to ensure there is no overcrowding at the gates. If there is a sibling at a later bubble or you arrive early we ask that you do not wait around the drop off and pick up gates. Maybe wait in your car or go for a short walk.

If your child is unwell please ensure you notify school immediately. It is important that you follow the government guidelines if the symptoms are Covid related. (See Covid section on the website)

If children are bringing a snack into school, please ensure that it is a healthy option and does not contain any nuts.

Can we also remind you that children should only bring into school their coat, book bag, water bottle and lunch box.

I appreciate that all the schools in the area have staggered starts and finishes and therefore there is parking issues but we ask that you do not stop or park on double yellow lines or over the residence driveways for the safety of everyone. We will have to ask you to move if you stop on the double yellow lines outside school.

You will have received a Flu immunisation letter. Please return this by Friday at the latest.

Thank you to everyone for all your support and for adapting to this new situation. Let's continue being kind to one another during this difficult time.
