

Dear Parents/Carers,

Following on from my letter on Friday here are our plans for transition for children not currently in school.

I am sure you appreciate the current climate makes it difficult for us to arrange transition for the children however we felt it was important for the children to see their new teacher in person. If you do not wish for your child to attend then we will ensure that your child's new class teacher phones home instead.

It is vital that we follow the guidance to ensure transition is carried out as safely as possible and therefore we are proposing that the children will come to school at an allocated time in small groups to meet their new teacher. This will take place outside before the class teacher has entered their bubble for that day. Parents are asked to drop their child/ren off at either the main gate or Reception gate and leave promptly. Children will have the opportunity to ask any questions and chat to their teacher about next year. We ask parents to ensure they are on time to collect when the session has finished. You will be sent a message with the time your child has been allocated.

Children who are currently in school will also get an opportunity to chat to their new teacher in a similar format so do not need to attend these sessions.
