ICT	What is cyber-bullying and what should you do if it happens? Create a PowerPoint presentation that includes a class definition, solutions & consequences. Can you find landmarks using coordinates? (Google Earth) - pin tool to display (and record coordinates). Contributing to a class blog to communicate with others. Upload content to a prep-prepared Seesaw template & comment on each other's posts. Creation of a virtual (circuit diagram software) and physical circuit (Raspberry Pi) in order to light up an LED & create a switch. Use text-based programming (Logo) to create poppies (linked with Remembrance Sunday). Recording and manipulating sound waves. Record jokes into Audacity. Amplify, then alter the pitch and tempo.	What did the Romans think of Britain? (Postcards from Hadrian's Wall – Word Processing and Image manipulation). Designing virtual mosaics – CAD. Create 3 designs that say something about you. Using sort to present data more effectively (comparison of weather in 2 locations using Excel). Do you trust this website? Analyse the Met Office website exploring factors that affect how trustworthy it is (e.g. date it was updated, author, purpose and links to other websites). Using sort to present data more effectively (linked to DT). Vote on which pizza toppings are the most popular and use ICT to create a simple bar chart to show this.	Using programming to solve problems. Complete Anna and Elsa Activity from Code.org, using IF statements and loops to solve a range of on-screen problems. Creating an animation using PowerPoint (The Water Cycle). Use the animation pane to time entry and exit animations to show to process of the cycle. Can you trace a route using Google maps? Use Google maps to trace local rivers (the Tyne and the Wear) from their source to their mouth. Using inputs and outputs to program a simulation. Use FlowGrid to program and loop inputs and outputs to effectively control a virtual mimic. How does ICT help us? Research and present how technology facilitate the completion of tasks and compare to how the task was performed previously.
