### YEAR 6 PARENTS

All year 6 parents should have received an email from school this week with information about how to apply for secondary school places for your child. |Here is a brief outline of the information sent out. Applying online is the simplest option. Go to www.sunderland.gov.uk/admissionsonline to complete your application. You can apply on a variety of devices including a phone, tablet and PC or alternatively you can visit City Hall where there are facilities to apply on line. The online facility is open during the preference period - 9 September to 31 October 2024 If it is not possible to access or submit an online application, a paper application form can be obtained by emailing school.admissions@sunderland.gov.uk or by telephoning 0191 520 5560. If you apply on a paper application form, you will be informed of your child's school place by letter, which will be posted second class on 3 March 2025.



### **HSBC VISITS**

This week, all children have taken part in assemblies and workshops with HSBC. Children learnt about the important jobs banks do to keep our money safe. Workshops included children in KS1 looking in imprinting coins and doing an interactive treasure hunt. In KS2, children learnt about the value of items they may want to buy, why it is good to save and the risk of fraud. HSBC also did a special session with our Problem-solving ambassadors which tasked them to work together to solve and complete tasks relating to the ways we spend money. It was great to see the children engage so well and ask so many interesting questions.


For any children in KS2 who is not entitled to free school meals there will be a small charge of £2.74 if they would like a 'Character Favourite' meal.
