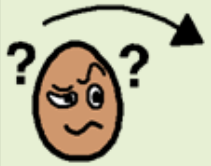

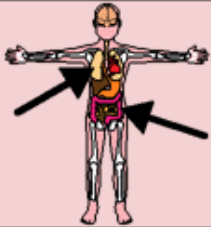
Ableism- Direct or indirect discrimination against people with disabilities or different neurotypes.



Communication- The giving and receiving of ideas and information with others.



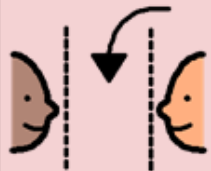
Echolalia- repeated word/phrases/sounds.



Interoception- the sense that helps the brain recognise the messages being sent from other parts of the body such as feeling hungry, feeling tired. -



Neurodiverse - recognises that there are different neurotypes. Different, not less.



Proprioception- the sense that helps the brain understand where the body is.



Sensory Processing- The way in which the brain organises sensations between the body and the environment.



Spectrum - a range of communication, sensory and processing needs and experiences that can be changeable.
