Free, volunteer-led, evidence based parenting programme. Each session is delivered by two Parent Group Leaders (PGLs) who have received 60 hours of training to deliver EPEC courses.

Our sessions empower parents to share experiences, learn new skills and practice these alongside other parents.

Who are the courses suitable for?

Our course offers an early, low level intervention, empowering parents to improve communication, behaviour management, family dynamics and parent-child relationships.

Any parents or carers of children aged over 2 and under 12 years are welcome to join.

Parents are supported and encouraged to try new parenting techniques each week and share the outcomes with other parents.

What is EPEC?

Empowering Parents, Empowering Communities (EPEC) is a volunteer-led, evidence-based parenting programme. Building on their existing sklls we train parents to become Parent Group Leaders (PGLs) who deliver EPEC sessions to other parents.

Our PGLs receive training, ongoing supervision and support from an EPEC Hub Co-ordinator based within the London Borough of Bromley.

What is the commitment? What do volunteers get?

PGLs must complete 60 hrs of training (a mix of online sessions, group discussions, reading, watching short films, actiities to complete at home along with some formal reflection on the learning). PGLs will be equipped to train online and in person. Read more about what volunteers receive below:
