KNIT AND NATTER CLUB YEARS 3-6

Dear Parents,

Once again this term, Funky Makers are volunteering to run a lunchtime knitting club for pupils in Years 3-6.

The club, called Knit and Natter, will allow pupils to learn some basic knitting techniques within a friendly social setting. The materials for this club are funded by Valley Primary School PTA.

The club will take place on **Tuesday** lunchtimes at 1pm and will be limited to a maximum of 4 pupils who are learning to knit for the first time and 4 pupils who already have some experience and can work independently on their projects with some input from the instructor.

As this club is in high demand, if a child does not attend knitting club for 2 weeks in a term without good reason their place will be offered to someone on the waiting list. If a pupil loses the needles & wool that have been provided to them there will be a £3 charge to replace the items before that pupil is allowed to attend club again. Pupils will also need to show evidence of items made with yarn obtained from club before being allowed to select additional yarn.

Also please note that this club is taking place in an area where a year 2 class has already returned from lunch. Children attending this class will need to conduct themselves appropriately so that we do not disturb learning in progress.
