Dear Parents,

Following the PTA AGM last November, you will all be aware by now that no one stood for the main committee positions of Chair Person, Secretary and Treasurer. As a result, the work of the school's PTA has been paused as we need to have named individuals elected to these positions.

Since the AGM, many parents have come forward to offer their support for the essential school fundraising and the future of the PTA – thank you to all those who have shared ideas and committed their support.

With everyone leading such busy lives, we need to ensure that the elected positions of the PTA are not seen as too onerous but, instead, are seen as manageable, privileged positions with everyone playing their part to reinforce that ageold saying of 'many hands make light work'.

Before the pandemic, Sarah Eaton-Sproule and her team had set about establishing small teams to organise and run calendar of termly PTA events. For example, there was a team who took the lead on running the school discos while another team took charge of the Grandparents' Tea event.
