




Roll a Sentence Punctuation Game

How to Play:

Remember:

- A full stop marks the end of a sentence (that isn't a question or exclamation).
- A question mark is used at the end of a question.
- An exclamation mark can end statements, commands and exclamations or can be after a single word or phrase.
