DHO. sound in: domingo aaosto Accents indicate the vowel is accents stressed. As seen in the words sábado and miércoles. This changes the 'n' to a 'ny' sound like in the English word ñ tilde 'onion'. As in the Spanish word cumpleaños. Words that end in a vowel, 'n' or 's' are stress normally stressed on the second to last syllable placement Like sep-tiem-bre,



No capital letter in the phrase above for the day of the week 'Monday' or the month 'July' in Spanish.
