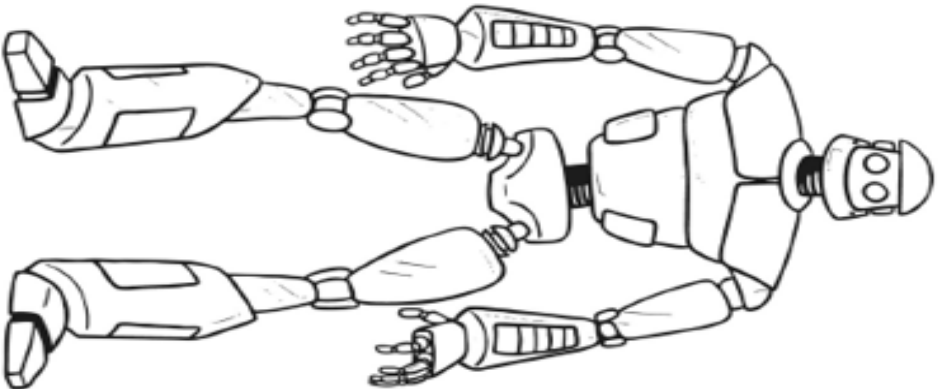
Task 1 – In this task you are going to try and find Iron Man a new home or a job. You will need to use persuasive language that makes people interesting in having or hiring him.
