Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you and your families are well and that your children have settled back into school well these first few weeks of the new academic year.

As you know, Victory Park Academy is due to join a new academy trust this year, as are the five other schools which are part of Parallel Learning Trust.

We wrote to you in the summer, when the General Election was called, to explain that the transfers would be held up because both the Government and local authorities would be unable to carry out much of their work until after the Election. The change of Government and the summer break have also meant that since July, the transfers haven't progressed as they would normally.
