Topic of Discussion	Notes
Stereotypical views are challenged and students learn to appreciate and view positively differences in others, whether arising from race, gender, ability or disability	Pupils feel that this aim could be improved and pupils could be challenged more. Inviting more guest speakers in and having assemblies around this could help improve awareness.
All students feel secure and are able to contribute appropriately	We have 3 pupil voice groups currently. We have weekly assemblies around certain topics within their own groups.
Students learn to take responsibility for their actions and behaviour in both the school and wider community	<ul> <li>Pupils feel that they could take responsibility more for their actions and work with the wider community. This could be done by charity work, D of E lessons, trips into the community, reflection, behaviour policy.</li> </ul>
Students have access to a curriculum which is relevant to them and which leads to greater appreciation of their own cultural traditions	Pupils feel that they could celebrate other cultures more. This could be done by having cultural celebrations weeks/days, themed cooking lessons.
