All pupils are identified as SEND and are monitored by the SENCo and SLT.

Through ongoing assessment, observations and working with families and services, where VPA are not able to support pupils' personal development, engagement and progress, we look to conduct a statutory assessment for further support.

Primary.

KS1 and KS2 class.
