


#### Coronavirus

 The new virus which was detected in December 2019



### **Key Statistics**

• Under 150,000 cases confirmed worldwide

Of people affected, the vast majority (~90%)
 completely recover or are in a "mild condition" –
 some are still being treated

• Around 3.5% have died (although not necessarily accurate)


 Mainly dangerous for those >65 years old and those with existing immune system issues

## Symptoms

- Coughing

- If you're feeling symptoms of infection, self-isolation until feeling better can help


#### Masks

- Antimicrobial Hand Sanitiser
  - Make sure it is "antimicrobial" not "antibacterial"

  - Before you leave
  - After using the toilet
  - Before and after eating
  - Sing "Happy birthday!" x2 during wash


