

Aims:

We aim to develop pupils' abilities within an integrated programme of speaking and listening, reading and writing. Pupils will be given opportunities to interrelate the requirements of literacy within a broad and balanced approach to the teaching of literacy across the curriculum, with opportunities to consolidate and reinforce taught literacy skills. We aim for all staff to have the confidence to see themselves as teachers of literacy.

At this school we strive for children to be "Literate Pupils" in its broadest sense

We aim for our pupils to be able to:

- read and write with confidence, fluency and understanding, orchestrating a range of independent strategies to self-monitor and correct
- have an interest in books and read for enjoyment
- have an interest in words, their meanings; developing a growing vocabulary in spoken and written forms
- understand a range of text types and genres be able to write in a variety of styles and forms appropriate to the situation
- be developing the powers of imagination, inventiveness and critical awareness
- have a suitable technical vocabulary to articulate their responses
