

SEPTEMBER 2020 Admissions Criteria for Wallace Fields Junior School

Where the school is over-subscribed for any year group, applications for entry in September 2020 will be ranked in the following order:

- 1. Looked after and previously looked after children
- 2. Exceptional social/medical need
- 3. Children who will have a sibling at Wallace Fields Junior School or Wallace Fields Infant School on the date of their admission and for whom either Wallace Fields Junior School or Wallace Fields Infant School is the nearest school to their home address
- 4. Children for whom either Wallace Fields Junior School or Wallace Fields Infants School is the nearest to their home address
- 5. Other children who will have a sibling at Wallace Fields Junior School or Wallace Fields Infant School on the date of their admission
- 6. Other children attending Wallace Fields Junior School

If within any category there are more children than places available, any remaining places will be offered to children who meet that criterion on the basis of proximity of the child's home address to the school. This will be measured to the nearest gate of either Wallace Fields Infant School & Nursery or Wallace Fields Junior School. The distance will be measured in a straight line from the address point of the child's home address, as set by Ordnance Survey to the nearest official school gate for pupils to use. This is calculated using the admissions team's Geographical Information System.
