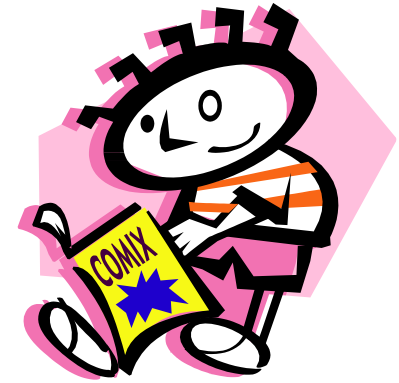
- Wear your school hoodie please!

- Money - €20 . Bring in small denominations and put in a named purse/wallet. Hand back to adults after each spending event.

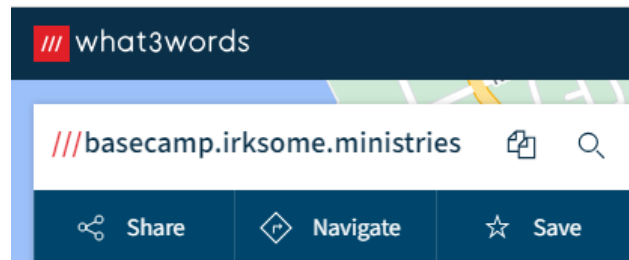
