# **HEAD'S UPDATE**

#### **File Server Crashed**

This Tuesday our file server crashed and was corrupted so the back up did not work. For two days our technical support tried unsuccessfully to repair it. Lots of files and data were damaged and cannot be retrieved. None of the data has been lost beyond school so there has been no data breach although we have a lot of work to catch up on. Fortuitously, we had already started moving over to cloud based systems with planning and teaching resources on the OneDrive and our timetables and development documentation on the Google Drive. In addition to this the school register system (SIMS), the safeguarding database (CPOMS) and payment system (Scopay) are all unaffected.

#### Year 6 Materials for D & T Week 9th December 2024

**Year 6 children will need fabric to make slippers.** Any old clothing e.g. fleeces, dressing gowns, sweatshirts etc would be absolutely fine but we appreciate some children may want specific fabric. The children will need about **1m x 1m** (it does depend on their foot size). If you want to check, measure over the highest point of your child's foot and add 3 cm, and the length of their foot + 4cm - we need enough fabric for 4 of those.

Also, if anyone has **any old vinyl flooring or old carpet underlay**- it would be much appreciated! We used to raid local flooring shops for their sample packs- though in recent

years they understandably have been unable to provide this for us. This forms the sole of the slipper.





# Support for Parents to Access Their Child's UK eVisa

The UK Government is replacing physical immigration documents with eVisas, a digital proof of immigration status.

Parents and guardians of children who are not British or Irish citizens, and whose children have either a biometric residence permit (BRP) card expiring on 31 December 2024, or a passport with an indefinite leave to remain ink stamp or vignette sticker, should take action to access their eVisa now<sup>16</sup>, and do so on behalf of their children too.

An eVisa cannot be lost or stolen and can be accessed online by visa holders at any time to prove their rights in the UK. It's free and their immigration status won't be affected.

# **Applying for a Junior School Place for September 2025**

### Do you have child starting school in September 2025

You can apply for a primary, infant or junior school place from 4th November 2024 if your child:

- was born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021, or
- is leaving Year 2 of an infant school in July 2025


