WFJS Book Club - Summer 2024

Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am delighted to let you know that WFJS Book Club will recommence in the summer term for Years 3 & 6 on Tuesday lunchtimes and Years 4 & 5 on Wednesday lunchtimes. Meetings will run *once a month* throughout the term to give your child the time to read the book before we meet again.

As a published children's author and journalist, I am passionate about reading for pleasure. I fully believe in the power of a great story to change attitudes and lives. Book Club is a fantastic enrichment activity which has proved highly popular. During each monthly session, we discuss books and reading in a fun, informal way (no writing or comprehension involved), with the emphasis on reading for pure enjoyment. If your child is stuck on a particular genre or author, or you feel has yet to learn to lose themselves in a book, this is a great way to encourage them to read more widely, enthusiastically and frequently. After each meeting you will need to source the book for your child from Amazon, a local book shop or the local library. Your child will then have four weeks in which to read it alone, or with your support before our next meeting. **The fee per child, per term is £15.**

What I offer:

- The opportunity for children to rediscover the joy of books and reading away from a formal classroom setting, with no expectations of SPAG, reading comprehension etc.
- An insight into the life of a working author and tips and encouragement for children who enjoy stories and might wish to write their own.

Your child will:

- **Grow** in confidence as they are encouraged to express and share their genuine views on the books they have read.
- **Expand** vocabulary organically as they read regularly and more widely.
- **Explore** the work of new authors and genres and begin to read outside their 'comfort zone'.
- Take part in monthly debates and fun termly quizzes.
- Enjoy the chance to recommend books and authors to their peers.
- Receive an end of year Certificate acknowledging their reading.
