


Long tables- server allocated Allergy table near adults

Key Points

Emergencies & Behaviour

- Your parents must be available or have a responsible adult available to collect you should your level of health or behaviour become unsuitable for the trip.
- Hospitalised (collection needed).
- A danger to yourself and others.
- Any other extreme circumstances.
