Sports Premium Funding £18,700.00 – Expenditure Academic Year 2022 - 2023

Sports Coach – Chris Sellars

We have a dedicated Sports Coach who teaches the children a range of sports across the academic year including football, hockey, athletics, cricket and more. Chris Sellars leads all “Games” lessons and provides progressive plans for all year groups to the PE subject lead. He ensures his lesson plans and curriculum outcomes align with the progression map to suit the knowledge and skills each year group should be learning. Chris teaches a range of curriculum sports and has proved to be a popular staff member among the children. He promotes the enjoyment of physical activity and instils values of team work, resilience and simply having a go, no matter what ability each child is.

Sports Leader – Chris Sellars

This academic year, Chris Sellars has taken over as Sports Leader. He organises and supports the extra-curricular sports events and competitions that WFJS attend. As part of this role, Chris completes all the admin for sporting events including communication with teachers and parents, liaising with all the Epsom and Ewell primary schools, feeding back into the weekly bulletin, Active Surrey and governors’ reports. He is also the leader at all sporting events that the school attends.

Chris helps train the school Netball Teams, Football teams (with assistance) and various ad-hoc sports, as well as coordinate the inter school football & netball matches, House Cross Country, District Cross-Country, Tag-Rugby teams, District Sports teams and runs Sports Day.

Overall, the Sports Leader helps the smooth running of the extra-curricular events that our children compete in. This gives opportunities across the school for pupils to have more participation in a range of sporting events.

Sports Leader Support – Louise Wilson

Louise Wilson is available to support the Sports Leader at busy times in the sporting academic diary. Namely, she helped set up and run the Sports Day events this academic year. These events were mini games that combined a range of sporting skills (throwing, jumping, playing golf, mini assault courses, etc.). With Louise’s help, Sports Day offered a range of activities were inclusive to all pupils and ensured all children were able to participate in a non-competitive element of the day.

Cost £ 400

Yoga Lessons

Following the success of last year's trial of yoga lessons, it was felt that the whole school would benefit from a yoga sessions as part of our Wellbeing initiative. Each class were provided with a yoga lesson where they could learn how to calm their breathing as well as learn useful stretches and poses to support their body. Teaching staff were able to observe these sessions and implement ideas and strategies into their own teaching when completing mindful activities.

Cost £ 475

Whole School Day Event – Samba Dancing

We ran a Samba workshop which allowed all children to experience dance from a new culture. All children participated in the workshop and learnt a new dance style.

Cost £ 100

Kit and Equipment

Additional school netball and football kits were purchased to give more variety in sizes for larger children. Children also voiced in School Council sessions that they would like more equipment on the playground so in order to promote positive play at lunch time, the school purchased new equipment for the children to play with.

Cost £ 1565

Dance Festival

A troupe of 12 dancers were trained to perform at the borough Dance Festival held at the Epsom Playhouse – minor costumes needed to be purchased also.

Cost £ 330

Active Surrey Sports Crew Training

We were very pleased to be able to train this year's Sports Crew and they have been a great help with promoting sport and active play outside of PE lessons. They promote positive play at lunch times by offering games for the lower key stage to join in with and they visit our adjoining Infant school to offer play time games to younger children. The Sports Crew also support our much larger events including Sports Days (they also helped at the infant school Sports Day) and our Wellbeing Days where they take each class for a 30 minute session and play active games for the children to enjoy. The opportunities which the Sports Crew provide enable other pupils to see the enjoyment that can be had out of physical exercise and active movement.

Cost: £225

Swimming Lessons

- Swimming lessons were mainly paid for by parental contributions, but where some did not / could not pay, we subsidised those children's lessons.
- Percentages of children achieving 25 metres or more in a recognised stroke:
 - Year 6 = 94.2% of children achieved this goal
1 child non swimmer (1.4%)
3 children non swimmers opted out 4.4% during provision.
 - Year 5 = 89.8% achieved this goal
6 children non swimmers (8.8%)
1 non-swimmer opted out (1.4%) during provision.
Non-swimmers go back to swimming sessions in Year 6.

Cost of additional top-up swimming lessons: £550

Total spend from September 2022 – June 2023 = £14,400

Planned expenditure until the end of the academic year:

- **New storage unit for hall gymnastics equipment - £2,500**
- **Continuation of payment to Sports Lead and Sports Coach for sessions in July plus the running of District Sports - £900**
- **I-pad/ Electronic device for Sports Lead to support organisation of events with parents via Spond - £900**

Total spend from September 2022 – Aug 2023 = £18,700
