IMPORTANT

INCONSIDERATE DRIVING AND PARKING

It is regrettable that some parents are still driving too quickly down the road, parking on the grass verges and parking on double yellow lines. It is sad that people put their own convenience ahead of the safety of the children and so the appeal to those parents and carers is;

- Please drive slowly and safely in the roads near the school
- Please <u>do not</u> park on the grass verges or block driveways
- Please <u>do not</u> park on double yellow lines
- Please turn around at the bottom of Dorling Drive
- Please <u>do not</u> do three point turns in the road (it blocks the flow of traffic)
- Please think of the safety of the children

The Surrey traffic warden is being called in next week to try to limit this kind of selfish parking and thoughtless driving. Individual parents will be getting emails informing them that their driving is inconsiderate near a school and it is hoped that people consider others before there is an accident outside the school. It is only fine for those

parents until it is their child that is injured or killed. Thankfully this has not happened so please help to keep it that way.

Energy Kidz drop off and collection: Please note that if you use Energy Kidz you are allowed to drive into the staff car park to do so. Please drive slowly and remember that all children should be accompanied past the main gates — there are also staff cars around and so safety needs to be maintained.




